1) Are potential vendors able to provide alternate bids, providing pricing for automated services, alternate cart sizes and once a week service?

Yes.

2) The Annual Franchise Fee is defined as "15% of commercial account revenues of the Contractor's gross revenue from the Contract entered into by Contractor and City per these specifications." Would Edgewood clarify this language to state that it is "15% of commercial account revenues of the Contractor's gross collected revenue from the Contract entered into by Contractor and City per these specifications".

*The City agrees to* "15% of commercial account revenues of the Contractor's gross *collected* revenue from the Contract entered into by Contractor and City per these specifications".

3) Would Edgewood be willing to include "storms, epidemics, and quarantine" in the force majeure language on page 9?

The City agrees to include this language.

4) Would Edgewood be willing to add language to the Indemnification sections (on page 10 and page 31, Section 12) that "excludes claims arising from the negligence of Edgewood, its employees, officers, and agents"?

The City agrees to inclusion of this language.

5) How is the "handicapped-status" of a resident determined/verified? (page 19, #4)

Due to HIPPA, no verification is requested.

6) Can you confirm that back/side yard service does not apply to Yard Trash? (page 20 #6).

Back and side yard service applies only to solid waste pick-up.

7) Would Edgewood consider removing glass (from Exhibit I) as an acceptable recycling material?

The City would like for glass to remain as a recyclable material; however, the City will not mandate if there is no market for it as a recyclable material.

8) Would Edgewood consider giving Contractor the right, upon notice, to reclassify materials as non-recyclables if contamination levels exceed 20% or there is no commercially viable market?

The City is amenable to this request.

9) Would Edgewood be willing to include "epidemic" to the Emergency Services Provisions? (page 23. Section F.1.)

Yes.

10) Do new 50 gallon or other sized (64 or 96 Gallon) garbage receptacles need to be supplied to all residential customers, or only those customers who request new receptacles? (page 29, Section 6D.)

Yes, be supplied to all residential customers.
